**UNAM's Research Residency Program**

The Office for Academic Staff Affairs (DGAPA, initials in Spanish) hereby invites all academic entities to present prospective outstanding academic leaders from foreign universities to apply for a fellowship to carry out a research residency in a Faculty, School, Center or Institute at UNAM.

**I. Purpose**

To strengthen the quality of scientific research and teaching activities in the academic entities by providing complementary funding so that distinguished academics appointed to foreign institutions may carry out a research residency at UNAM, as well as promote international collaboration.

**II. General Conditions**

1. Research residency applications shall be subject to the *Operating Rules of the UNAM's Research Residency Program*, published in *Gaceta UNAM*, the Institution official magazine (<http://dgapa.unam.mx>)
2. Candidates must present a research project or an educational innovation project and submit all the documents established in the Operating Rules.
3. Applications will be assessed by the Technical Evaluation Committee of the *UNAM's Research Residency Program*, based on their quality, impact and the availability of funding.
4. Candidates must have an outstanding and well consolidated record or achievements evidenced by an ample body of published works and proof of their teaching and mentoring activities, they must also obtain authorization from the Technical or Internal Board of the receptor academic entity. Proof must be provided of their status as full-time and tenured professors of a foreign research institution or institution of higher learning. In exceptional instances, consideration will be given to proposals submitted for proposals of distinguished retired professors which rest on solid grounds. In this case, the Technical Review Board will decide on their participation in the program. She/he must evidence compliance with the obligation and/or commitments.
5. The selected candidates must comply with the *Operating Rules of the UNAM's Research Residency Program*.

**III. Procedure Regulations**

1. The Technical Evaluation Committee of the program will assess only fully completed applications.
2. The proponent academic entities must receive, analyze, endorse and pre-select the candidates and will submit their complete applications to DGAPA, according with the following calendar:  
  
PERIOD 2019 I - Deadline for submission is February 8, 2019  
PERIOD 2019 II- Deadline for submission is August 2, 2019
3. Evaluation results will be published on:  
  
PERIOD 2019 I - March 26, 2019  
PERIOD 2019 II - October 1st, 2019
4. Late or incomplete nominations that do not meet the requirements shall not be considered.
